



Sustainable Forestry Policy Mohawk Flush Doors

Mohawk Flush Doors is committed to implementing the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) Standards addressing chain of custody (FSC-STD-40-004), controlled wood (FSC-STD-40-005), and on-product labeling (FSC-STD-40-201) for its wood and fiber procurement and component manufacturing operations.

Mohawk Flush Doors implements best efforts to avoid trading in wood and wood fiber that is: a) illegally harvested, b) harvested in violation of traditional and civil rights, c) harvested where global conservation priorities are threatened, d) harvested in natural forests being converted to plantations or non-forest uses, and e) from forests in which genetically modified trees are planted.

Mohawk Flush Doors' Policy is to promote and achieve the Principles of Sustainable Forest Management including: practicing sustainable forestry, employing responsible practices, regenerating the forest and maintaining productive capacity, protecting and maintaining long-term forest and soil productivity, protecting water resources, protecting special sites and biological diversity, complying with legal requirements, and continually improving forest practices.

Mohawk Flush Doors is committed to comply with applicable laws and regulations in the countries, states and regions in which it operates.

To help implement and achieve the above Sustainable Forestry Standards, Mohawk Flush Doors has developed and adopted appropriate documents, manuals and procedures to guide its wood and fiber procurement, tracking of the chain of custody of wood and fiber, and making off-product claims and using FSC on-product labels.

The company is committed to annually monitor and review the effectiveness of its Sustainable Forestry Policy and associated programs to continually improve conformance.
